

## EasyIQ Website Block

Do you have control of which websites your students have access to?

EasyIQ Website Block allows teachers and the IT personnel to block websites that are inappropriate in an educational context. Consequently, EasyIQ Website Block functions as an effective pedagogical tool which can block the access to websites containing, e.g. online games, chat sites or downright illegal content.

### A user-friendly solution

In order to form the best view of the blocked websites, it is possible to create an overall category, e.g. 'online games', and in this category block a number of websites, for instance worldofwarcraft.com. In this way, you have the possibility to create an unlimited number of overall categories containing an unlimited number of websites. The blocking may be set to last for a time-limited period down to 15 minutes or permanently. The actual activation will take effect within one minute, making it unnecessary to plan a blocking in advance.

### A tailored solution

As the functions in EasyIQ Website Block are based on the settings in the ISA server, it is possible to tailor EasyIQ Website Block to match the IT policies of the individual educational institution. As a result, the educational institution is given the opportunity to define e.g. whether the blocking should concern the regular users only or guest users as well. EasyIQ Website Block facilitates the task of uniting different IT policies, e.g. in case of merger between different educational institutions.
